

Instructions for International Wire Transfers

When making an international wire transfer to a bank account in Japan, please be advised that additional fees may be incurred based on the policies of intermediary and receiving banks in Japan.

To ensure that the full invoiced amount is received without any deductions, **we strongly request that you select the payment option “OUR”** when completing the remittance application at your bank.

Below are the standard payment options used in international wire transfers:

- **BEN (Beneficiary):** All fees, including those charged by the remitting and receiving banks, are borne by the recipient.
- **OUR (Applicant):** All fees, including those charged by the remitting and receiving banks, are borne by the sender.
- **SHA (Shared):** Remittance fees are paid by the sender, while receiving bank charges are paid by the recipient.

To avoid any shortfall in payment, please select **“OUR”** as the fee payment option.
